Health and Safety Policy Statement

Car Park Services (CPS) recognises and accepts its duties and responsibilities under the Health & Safety at Work Order 1978 and all other statutory requirements and codes of practice which relate to the company's activities for the health, safety and welfare of all those working for or on behalf of the company and all persons likely to be affected by its activities including the public, where appropriate.

CPS's commitment is to provide, so far as is reasonably practicable, a safe working environment to prevent the injury or ill health of all those working for or on behalf of the company and any other person affected by its activities, and as a minimum to comply with all relevant regulations. In light of this the company operates a health and management system in accordance with the requirements of OHSAS18001:2007.

Those persons under the control of the company also have a statutory duty to take reasonable care for themselves and others who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work.

To enable CPS to carry out these duties responsibilities for health and safety matters are to be effectively assigned, accepted and implemented at all levels within the organisation.

The company will ensure that risks are identified and controlled so that those working for or on behalf of the company and others can be protected from danger thereby ensuring that injury and ill health are prevented.

The company recognises its obligations in providing:

- A Safe place of work including safe access/egress
- Safe work practices, equipment and machinery
- Suitable protective clothing and equipment where hazards cannot be eliminated
- Appropriate information, instruction, training and supervision
- Systems for prevention of risk to health from any activity or substance
- Systems for maintaining welfare and hygiene facilities are appropriate
- Systems preparation and revision of emergency safety statements/plans
- Competent resources in the form of training personnel, internal or external, to the Company, where the necessary expertise is required to advise and assist in securing the health, safety and welfare of those working for or on behalf of the company.

It is the duty of all those under the control of the company:

- To take reasonable care for the health & safety of themselves and of other persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work and to cooperate with CPS in fulfilling its statutory duties.
- Not to interfere with or misuse anything provided in the interest of health and safety.

The health and safety policy will be reviewed at least annually, amended and updated as and when necessary. Appropriate OH&S objectives will be set where necessary. Communication of any such developments will be made to all persons acting for or on behalf of the company.
